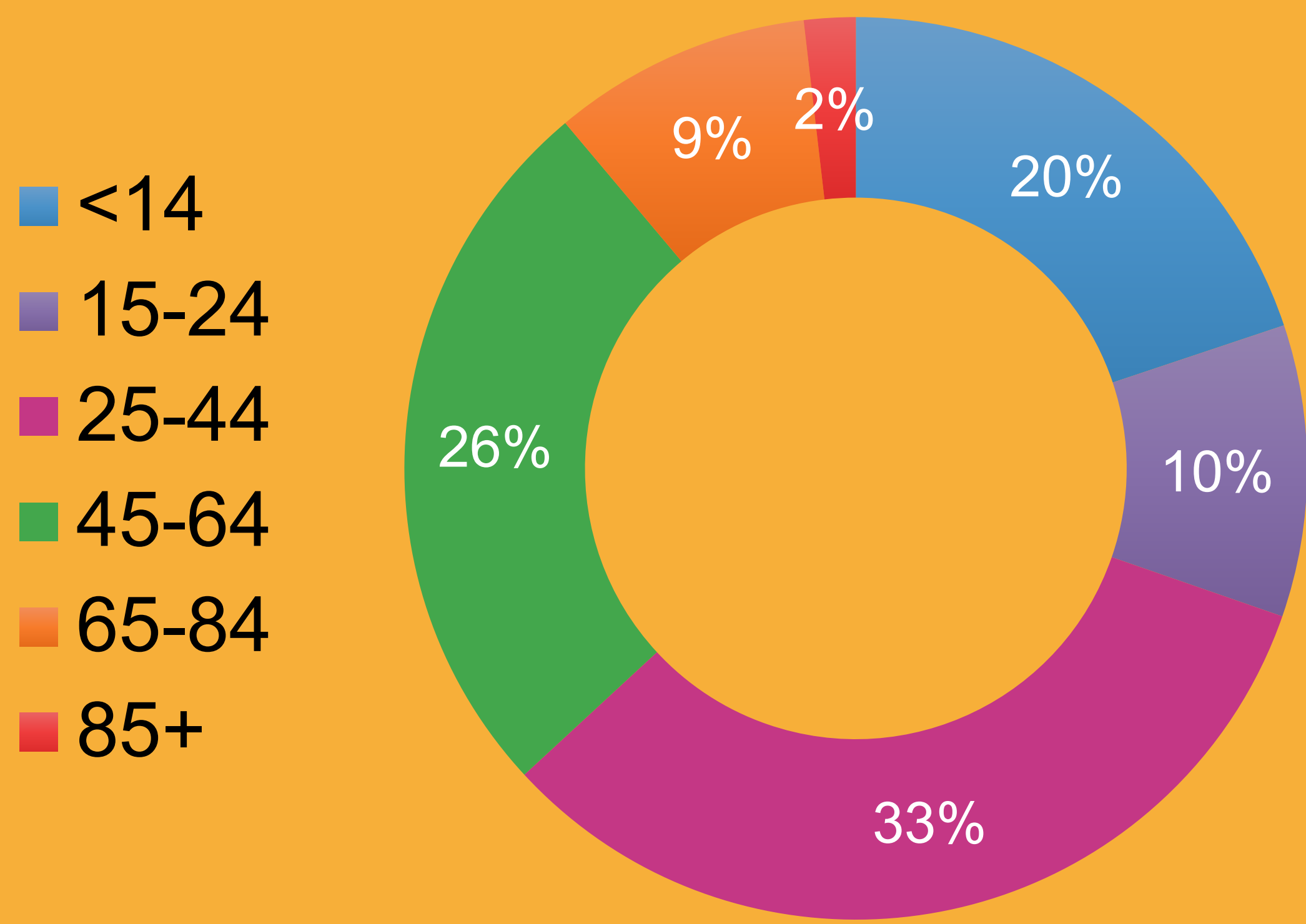

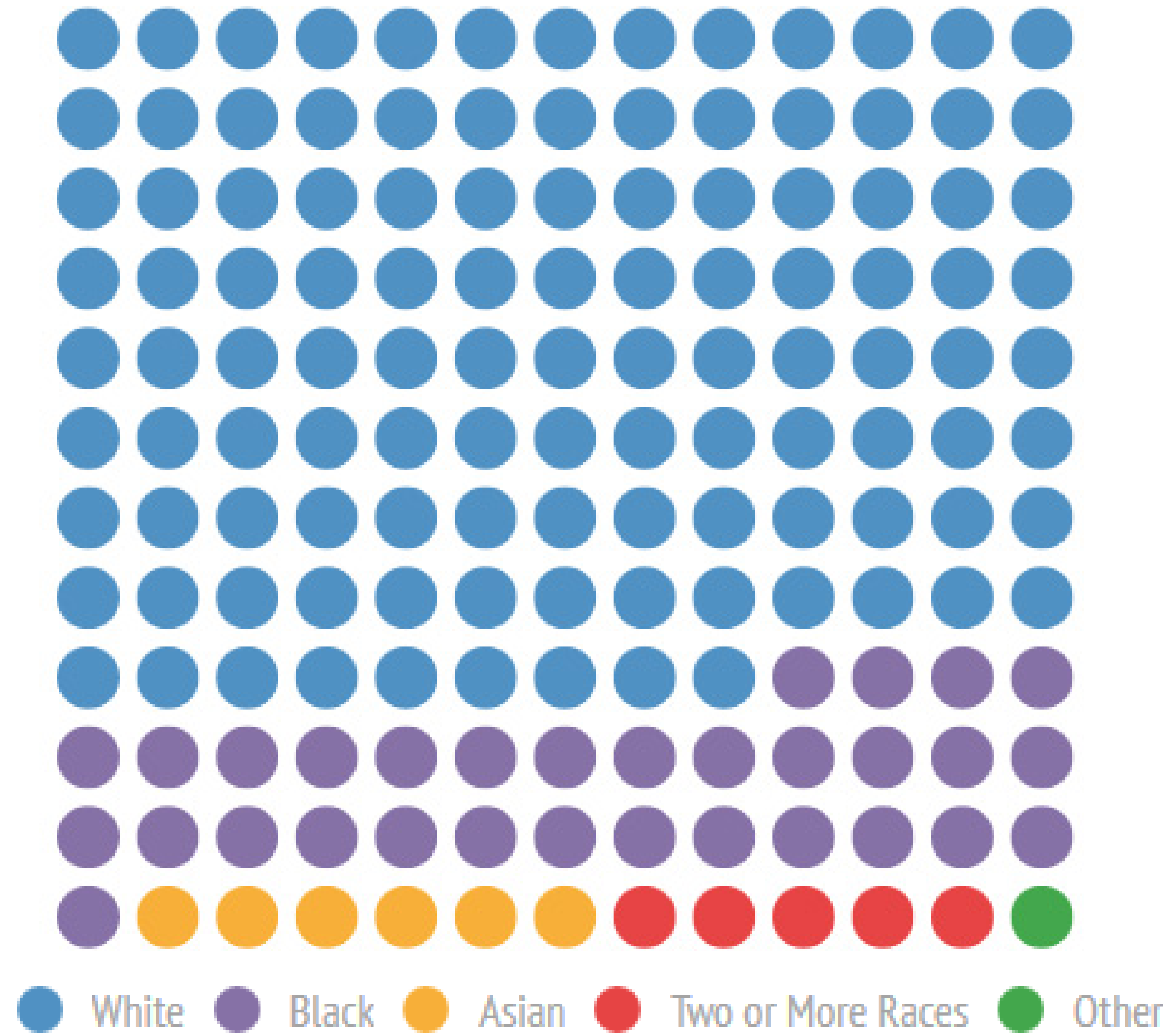
Age Distribution 2010:



Young and middle aged adults combine for 59% of the population. Children make up 30%.

Race Distribution 2010:

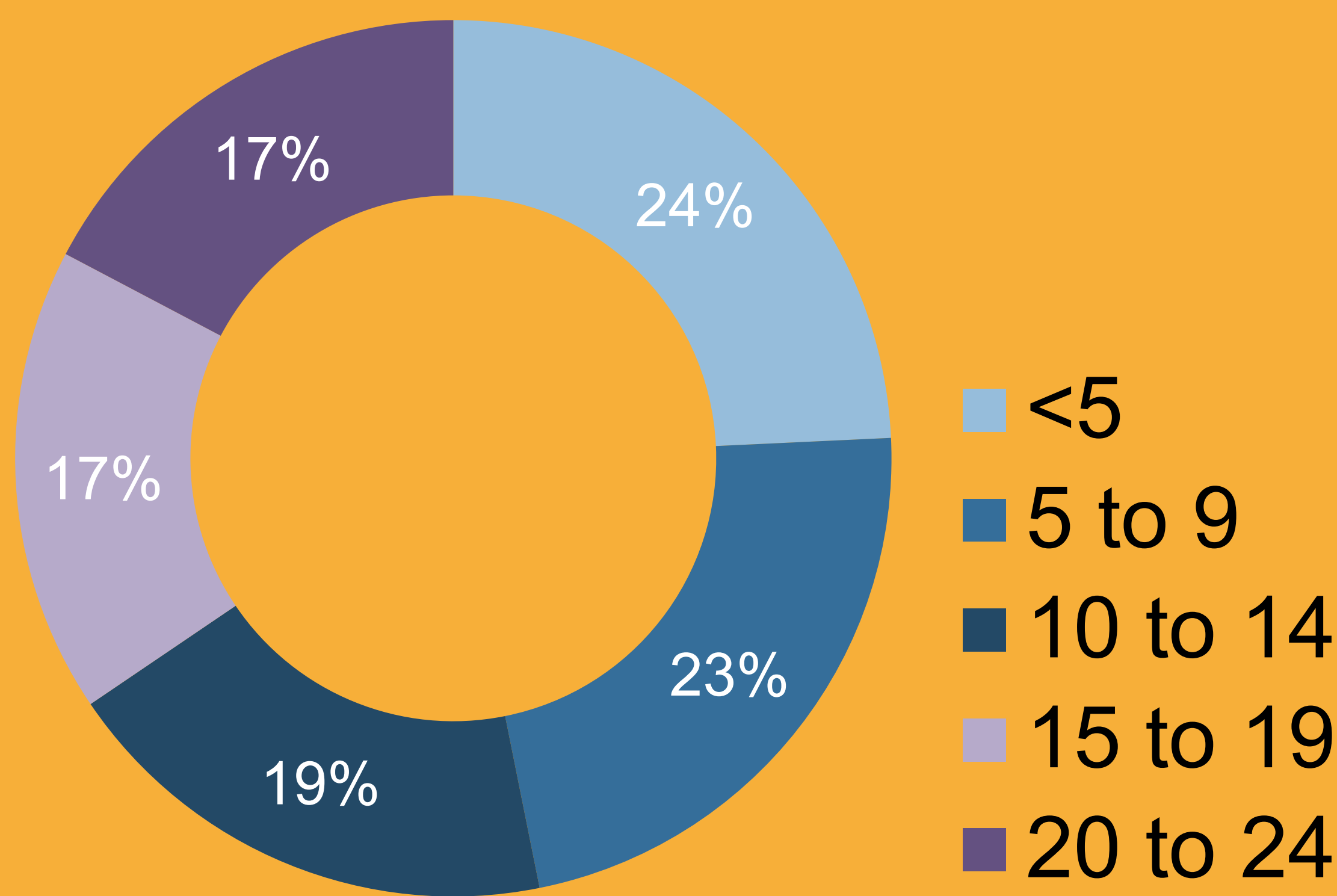


White people make up 72.1% of the racial distribution in Decatur as of 2010. Black people make up 22.9%, Asian people 2.1%, and those of Hispanic origin of any race are 3.9% of the population.

Age Distribution of School Aged Children:

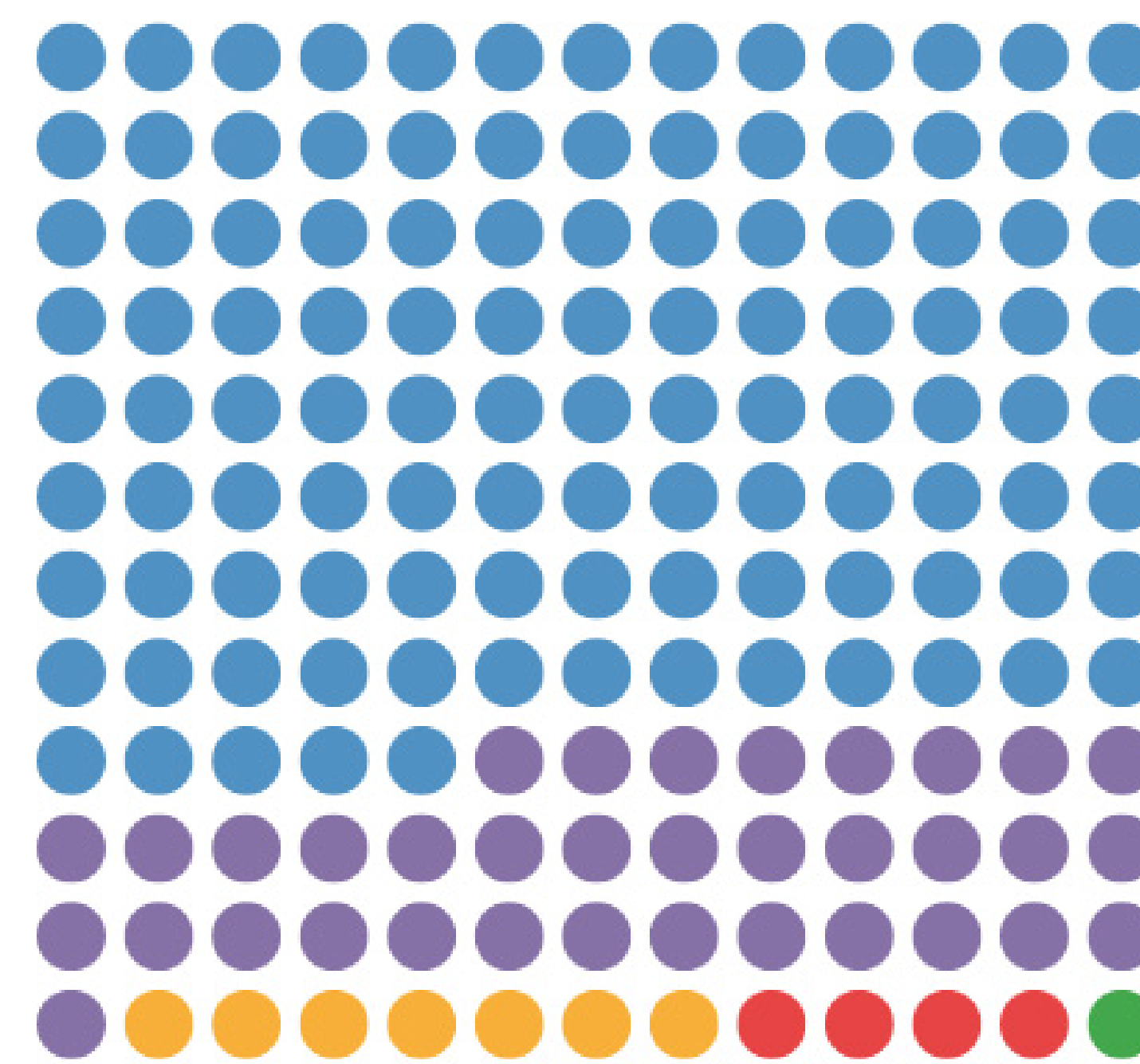
Children and young adults under 24 make up 30% of the total population. There is a larger proportion of young children (those under the age of 9) in Decatur than older children.



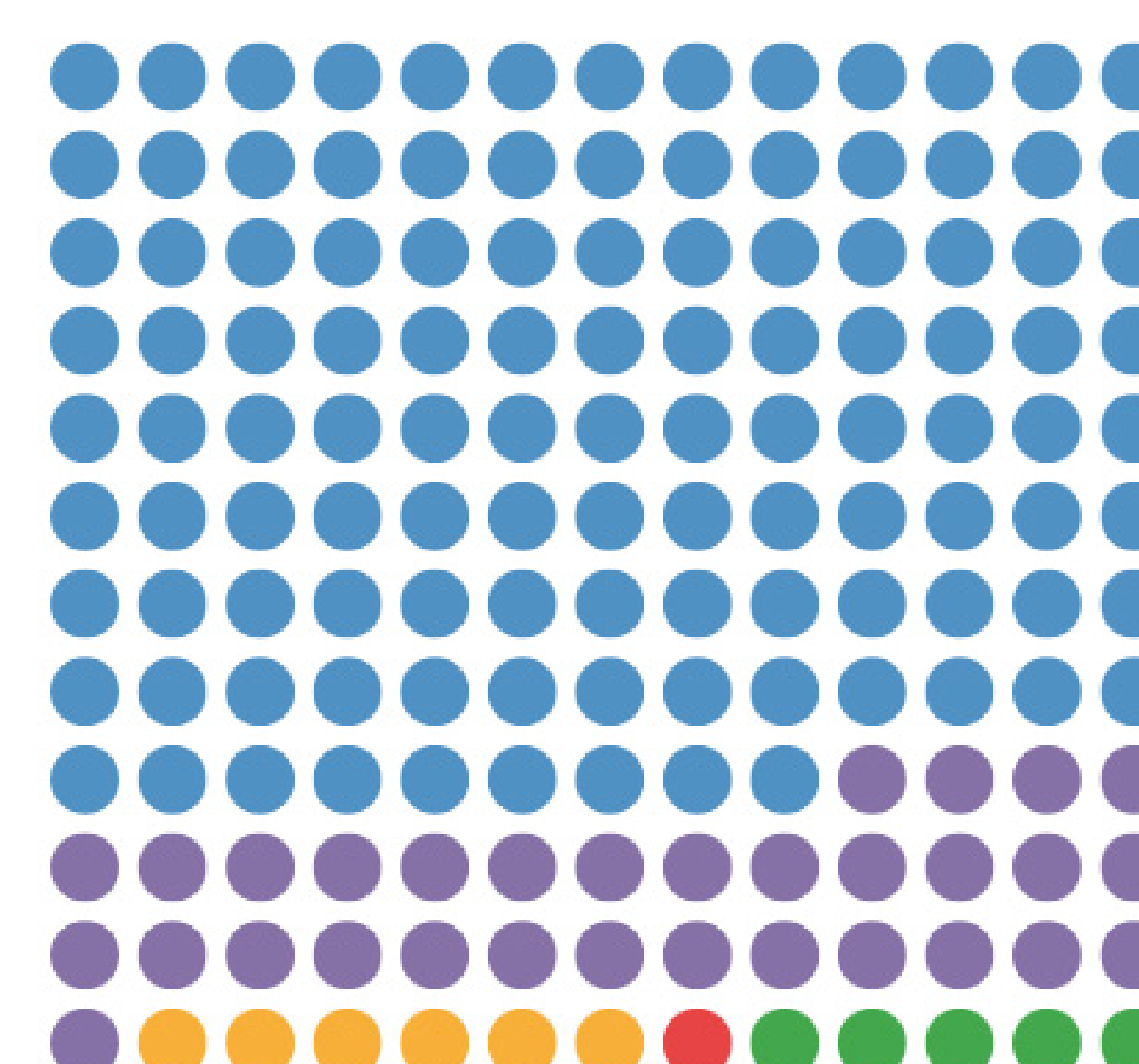

2020

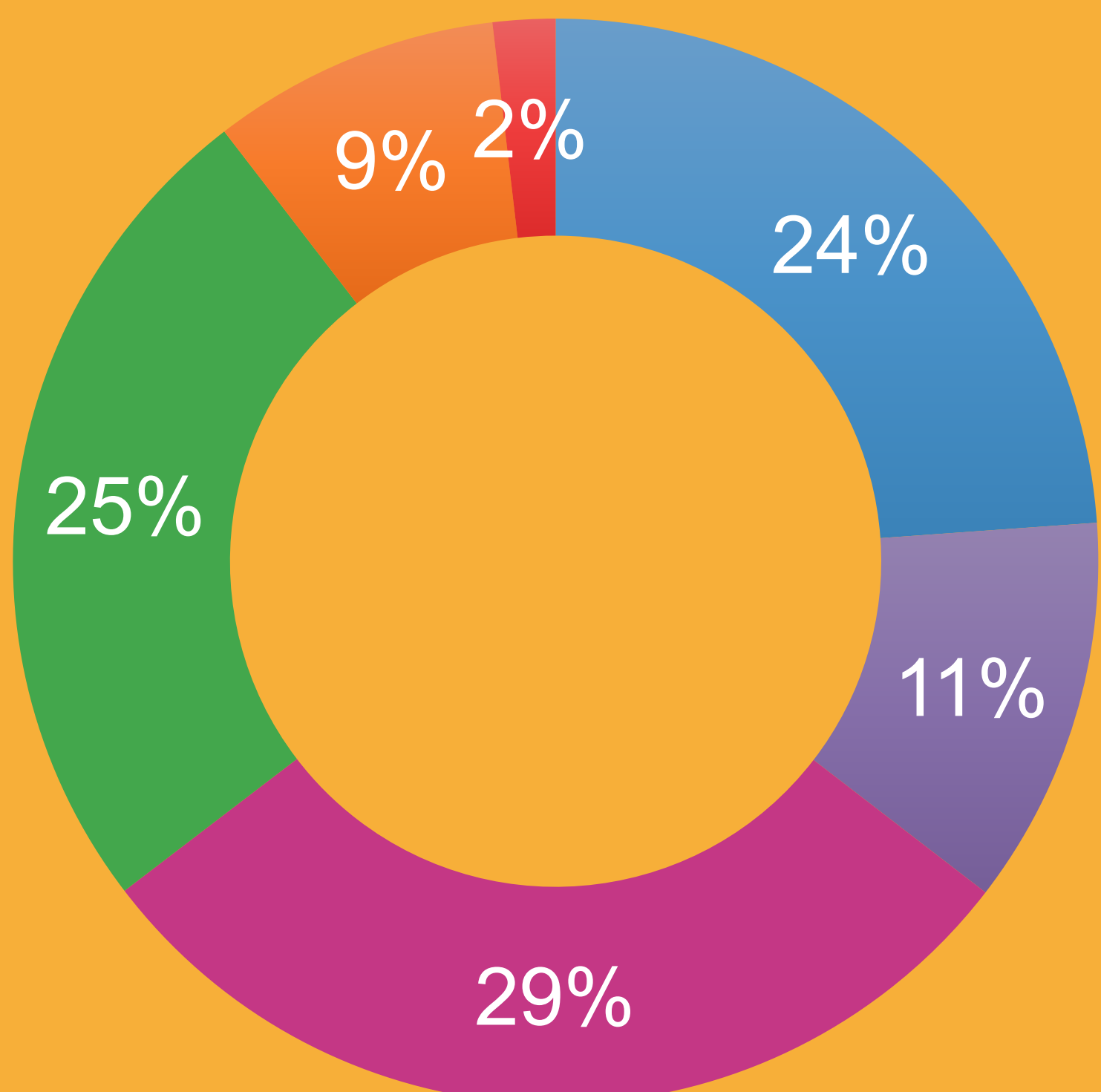


Proportions of White residents and Black residents decreased between 2010 and 2014 while Asian residents and residents of two or more races increased. The proportion of Black residents is expected to continue to decline while White residents is predicted to increase into 2020.

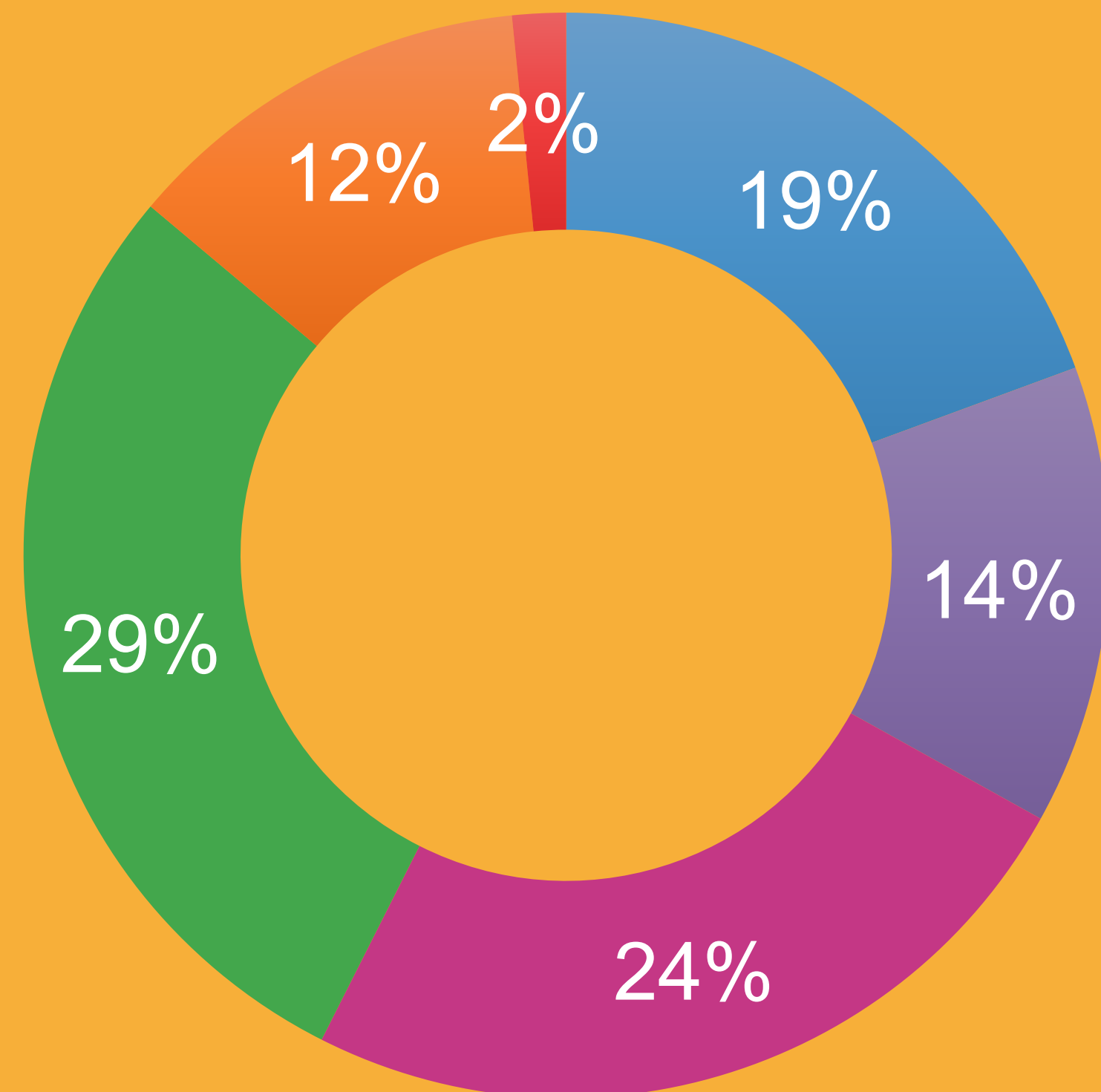
