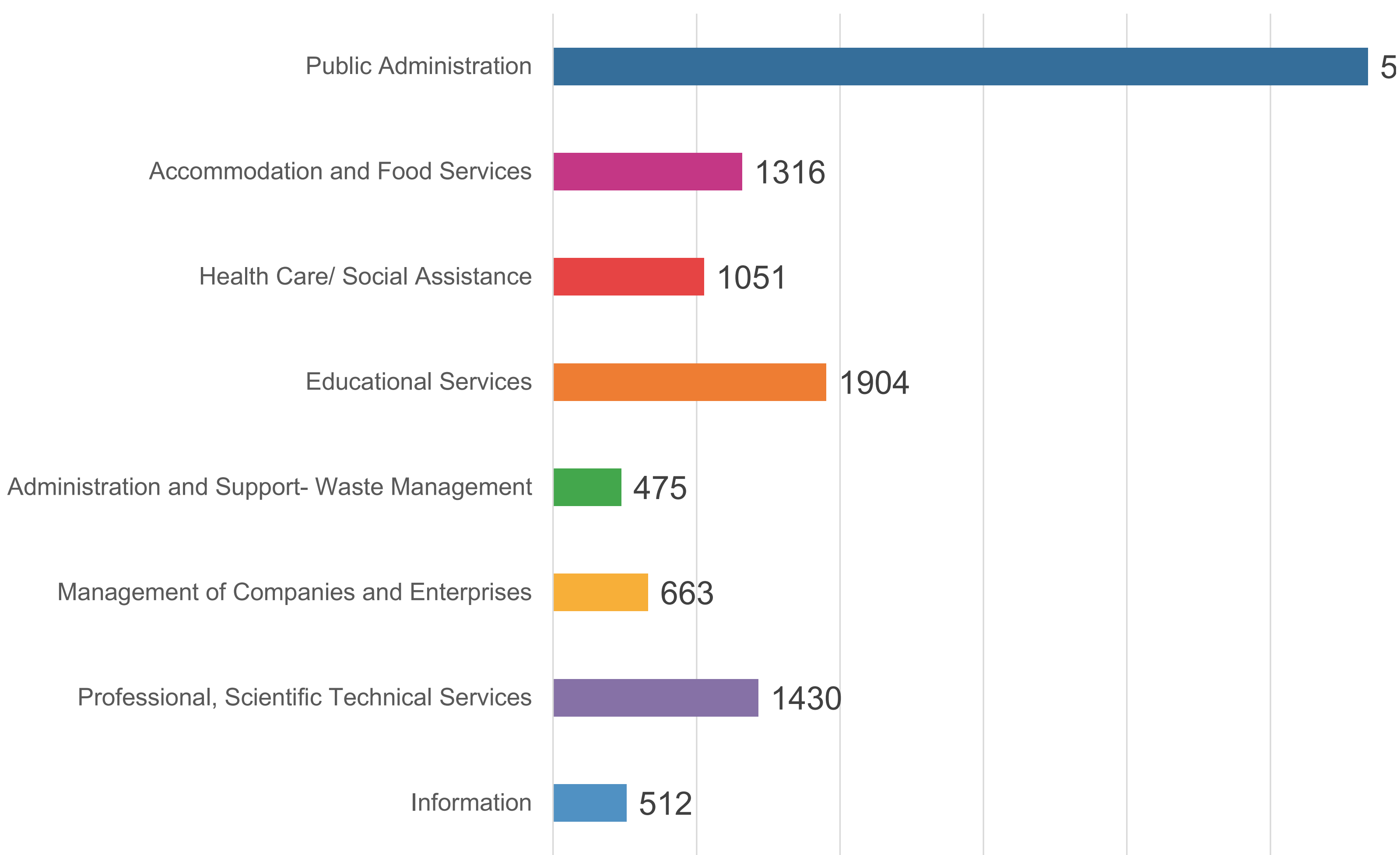
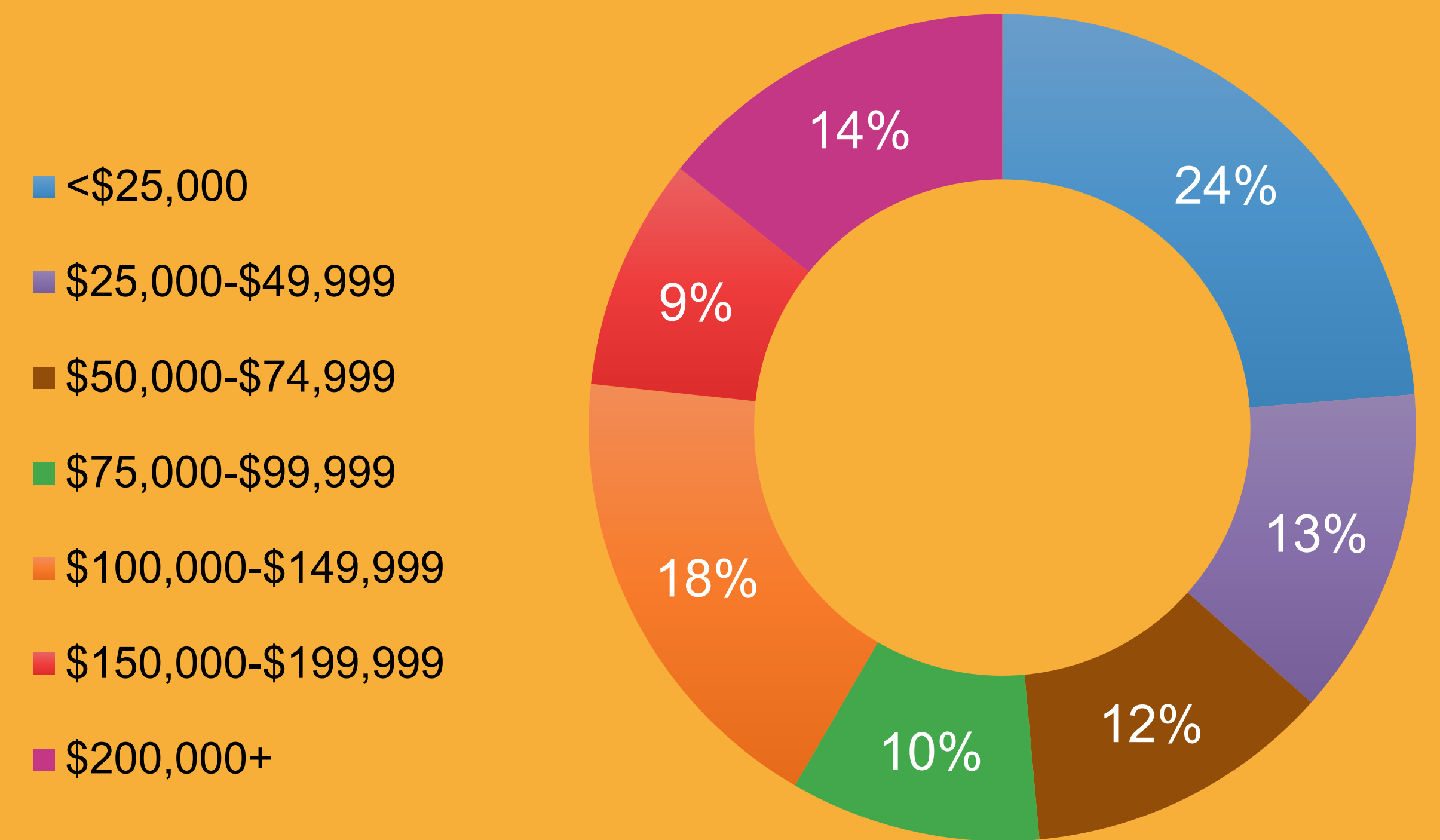

41% of Decatur's households make more than \$100,000 a year, and 37% make less than \$50,000 annually

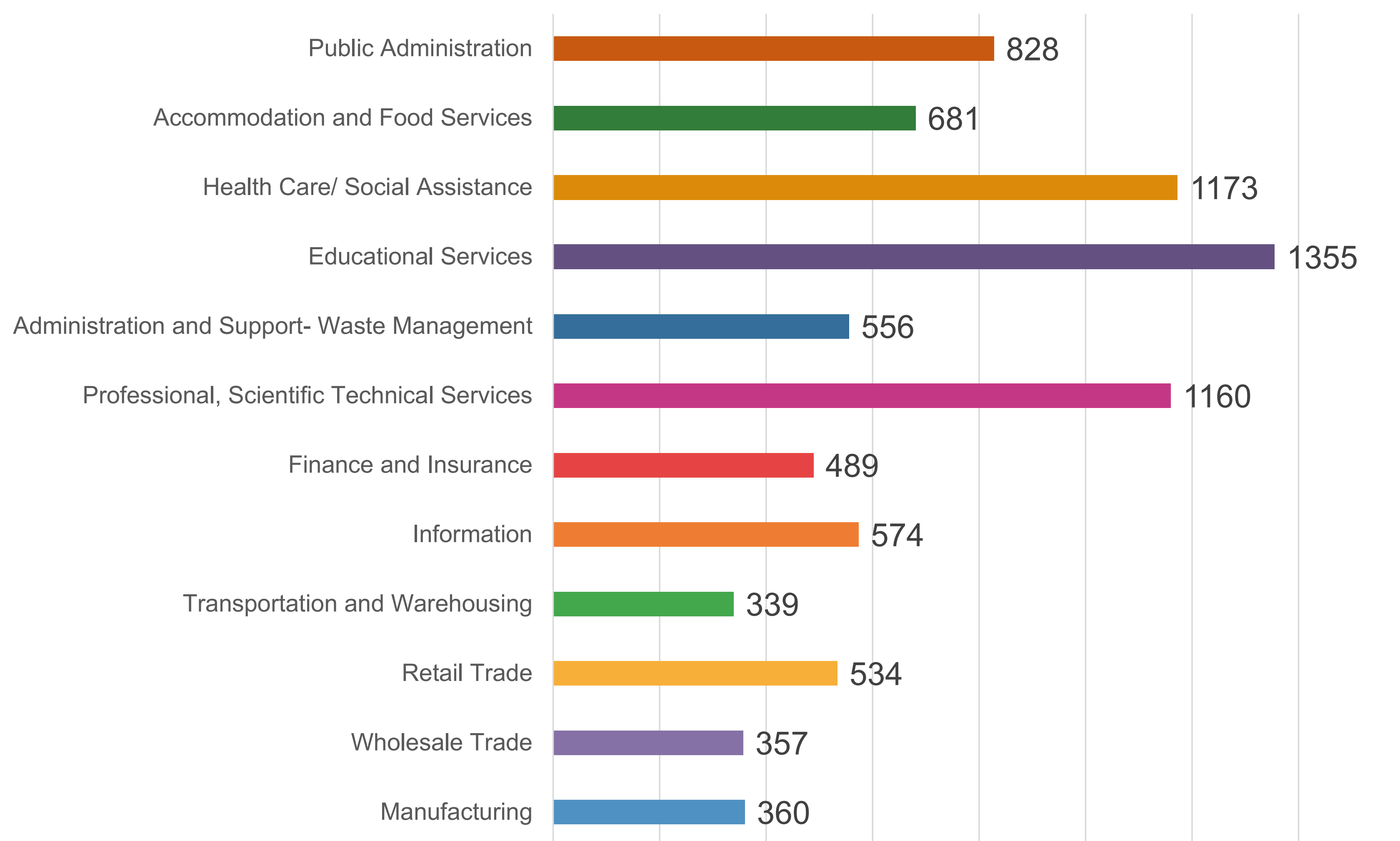

Workplace Area Characteristics 2014:

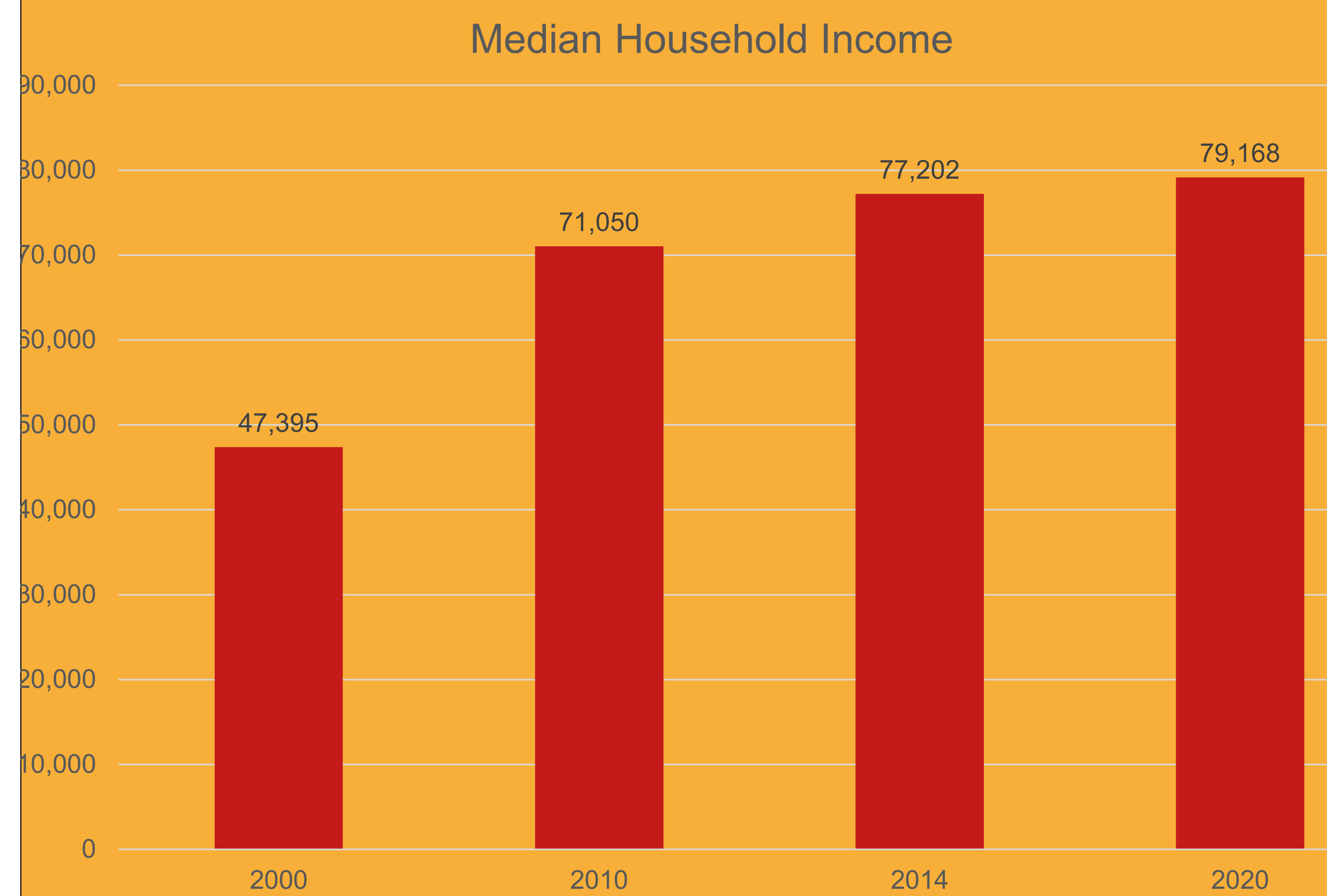

Note: Industries with fewer than 3% of Decatur jobs were excluded for clarity including Construction, Retail Trade, Finance and Insurance, Real Estate, and Other Services.

Resident Area Characteristics (RAC) describe the industry that residents of a certain area work in for a living. The most popular industry is Educational Services, and the second most common is Health Care. Note: Industries with fewer than 3% of the jobs for Decatur's residents were excluded for clarity including Construction, Real Estate, Management, Arts and Entertainment, and Other Services
