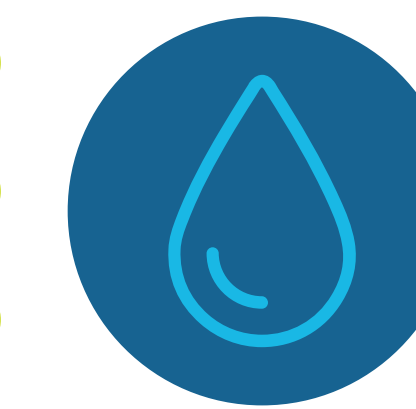


About the 2020 Stormwater Master Plan (SWMP):



Purpose:

- Address the City of Decatur's future management of stormwater.
- Address and prevent flooding and improve quality in the City's Streams.
- Evaluates stormwater concerns across the City and prioritizes solutions to address concerns.



Need:

- To update the SWMP through 2040.
- To focus on stormwater management in residential areas of the City.

Goals:



To improve stormwater management in Decatur's neighborhoods, public spaces, and rights-of-way



To mitigate environmental impacts from urban runoff

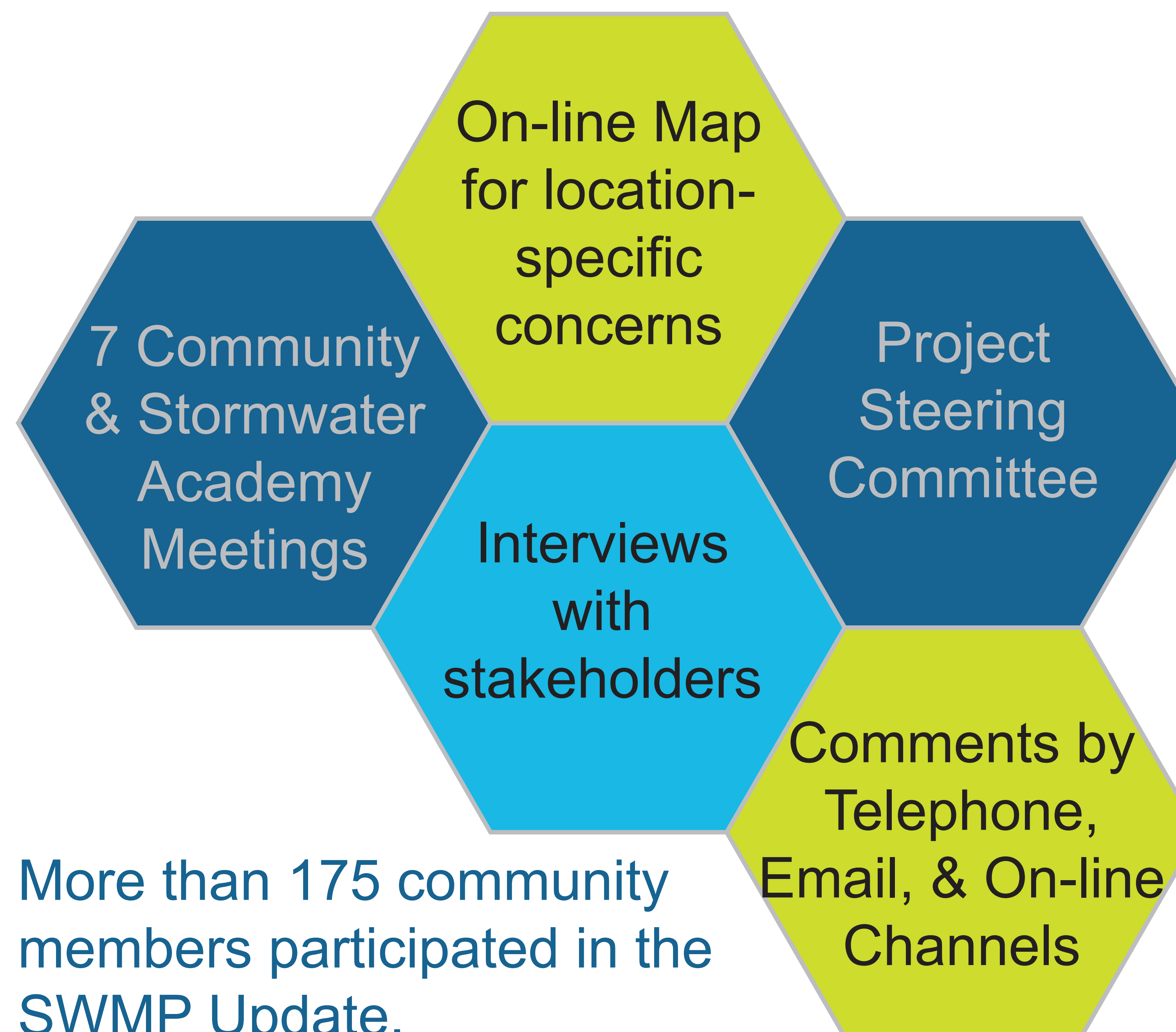


To improve the water quality in the City's watersheds

More than 175 community members participated in the SWMP Update.

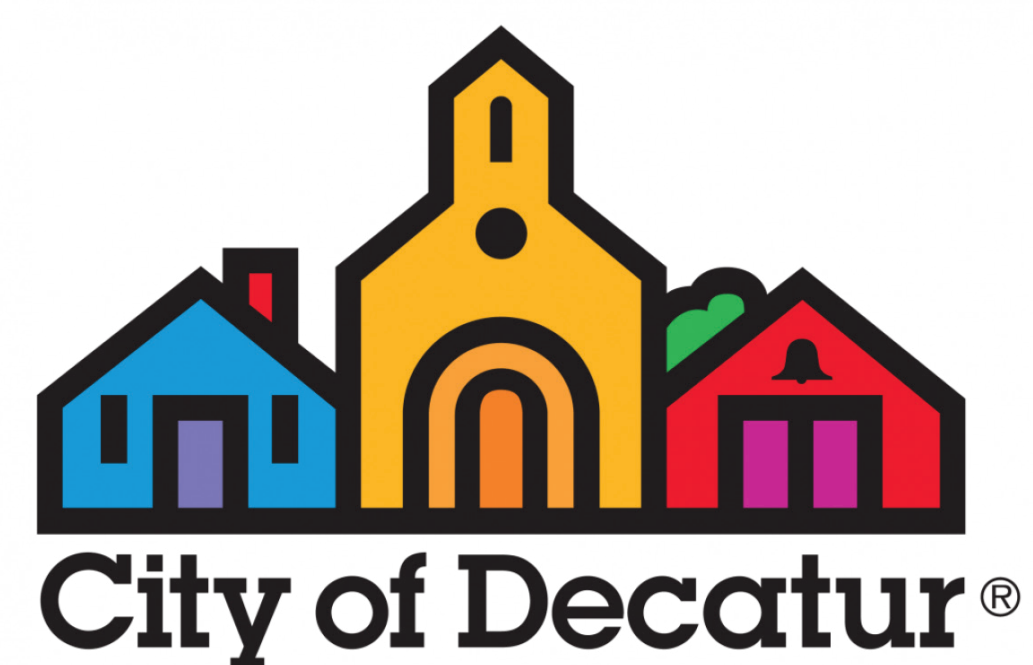
